

### **HUXLEY CORN BREEDING**

We want you to work for Monsanto! We are looking for crew members for the summer to assist in a variety of essential tasks in our breeding and research program.

## **POLLINATING CREW**

Pollinating season starts in the beginning of July. Pollinations will all be done in Huxley, IA. Monsanto will provide transportation for this season which includes bus pick up at centralized locations. Pollinating hours vary greatly upon the weather. A normal work day will begin with busses leaving their respective locations at 6:30 AM and usually returning no later than 4:00 PM. Starting wage is \$10.00/hr. *The minimum age requirement for pollinators in Iowa is 14 years*.

### REFERRAL PROGRAM

Monsanto does have a referral program. Tell your friends Monsanto is looking for summer crew members. For each friend that comes to work, Monsanto will give you a gift card. Your friend must be new to Monsanto and work the entire season. If you need more applications do not he sitate to call or email.

### **WORK HOURS AND BREAKS**

The length of the work day and work season is uncertain due to the impact of weather conditions. Employees need to be flexible, especially at the beginning of the season. Normal working hours are **6:30 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Saturday.** Please note Saturdays are mandatory for pollinating.

#### PICK UP AND DROP OFF SERVICES

Depending on where we receive the most applicants for our pollinating crew, Monsanto will determine a centralized pick up location traditionally in Ankeny, Ames, and Huxley. More details will be given closer to orientation.

# **ORIENTATION AND SAFETY TRAINING:**

Employees are required to go through orientation and will be compensated for their time. Orientation consists of two portions, Safety/Personal Conduct and Field Training. The first half covers all the policies Monsanto has on safety and personal conduct while working for Monsanto and the second half will be hands on training on the different processes employees will perform during their tenure.

Orientations for the pollination crew are offered on two dates for the season, only one need be attended. Training will start at 8:00 AM and last until approximately lunchtime. Lunch will be provided. Dates for training will be announced in late May or early June, and are commonly held in late June.

# **CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT**

- 1. Pay rate and pay periods will be announced at the time and offer of employment is made.
- 2. Hours worked per day will vary.
- 3. Shoes must be in good condition. Open toed shoes or worn out shoes will not be allowed. High top shoes provide good stability for your ankle and are strongly encouraged.
- 4. You may be required to work in the hot sun, rain, irrigation, water or mud.
- 5. An information line is available to call prior to reporting for work when weather may prevent work. Should adverse weather prevent field work, the message will be updated as necessary. You will be given instructions and phone number on your first day of work.
- 6. While on a bus, in a company vehicle, or at work in the field, you will be under the supervision of field personnel and you must follow his/her instructions.
- You will be expected to conduct yourself properly at all times.
- 8. Lunchtime is not considered part of the work period.
- You will be exposed to pollen, sun, heat, and insects. This exposure could be a health problem for individuals with allergies or asthma.
- 10. The employer is **not responsible** for personal property lost or stolen.
- 11. Use of cellular phones is **NOT** permitted in the field.
- 12. Transportation will be furnished from the office to the field and back.
- 13. On the first day of hire, you will need to complete Part 1 of the Form I-9; by the third day of employment you must bring approved documents to provide verification of your eligibility for employment. Listed below are common forms of identification that establish identity and employment eligibility. Other documents listed on the I9 form may also be provided to establish employment eligibility:
  - GROUP A: Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)

A U.S Passport **OR** One EACH from Group "B" and "C"

GROUP B: State Drivers License or ID card with photograph

UNDER AGE 16: School record or report card, clinic, doctor or hospital record, school ID card with photograph

GROUP C: Original Social Security card, original or certified copy of a birth certificate.

- 14. Parents or guardians of minors are to contact the Employer directly if any problems arise.
- 15. Because of Federal, State, and Company regulations, certain behaviors and situations are not allowed and **violations can result** in immediate termination. Some examples include:
  - NO tobacco use for minors
  - NO alcohol or illegal drugs on Monsanto's property
  - NO guns, knives or other weapons allowed on Monsanto property.
  - NO vulgar language
  - NO speeding or reckless driving on Monsanto property. This includes personal vehicles entering or existing the workplace.
  - NO fighting or horseplay, including any throwing of items or shooting paperclips with rubber bands.

Because of the potential for injury, any such behavior will result in immediate termination.
